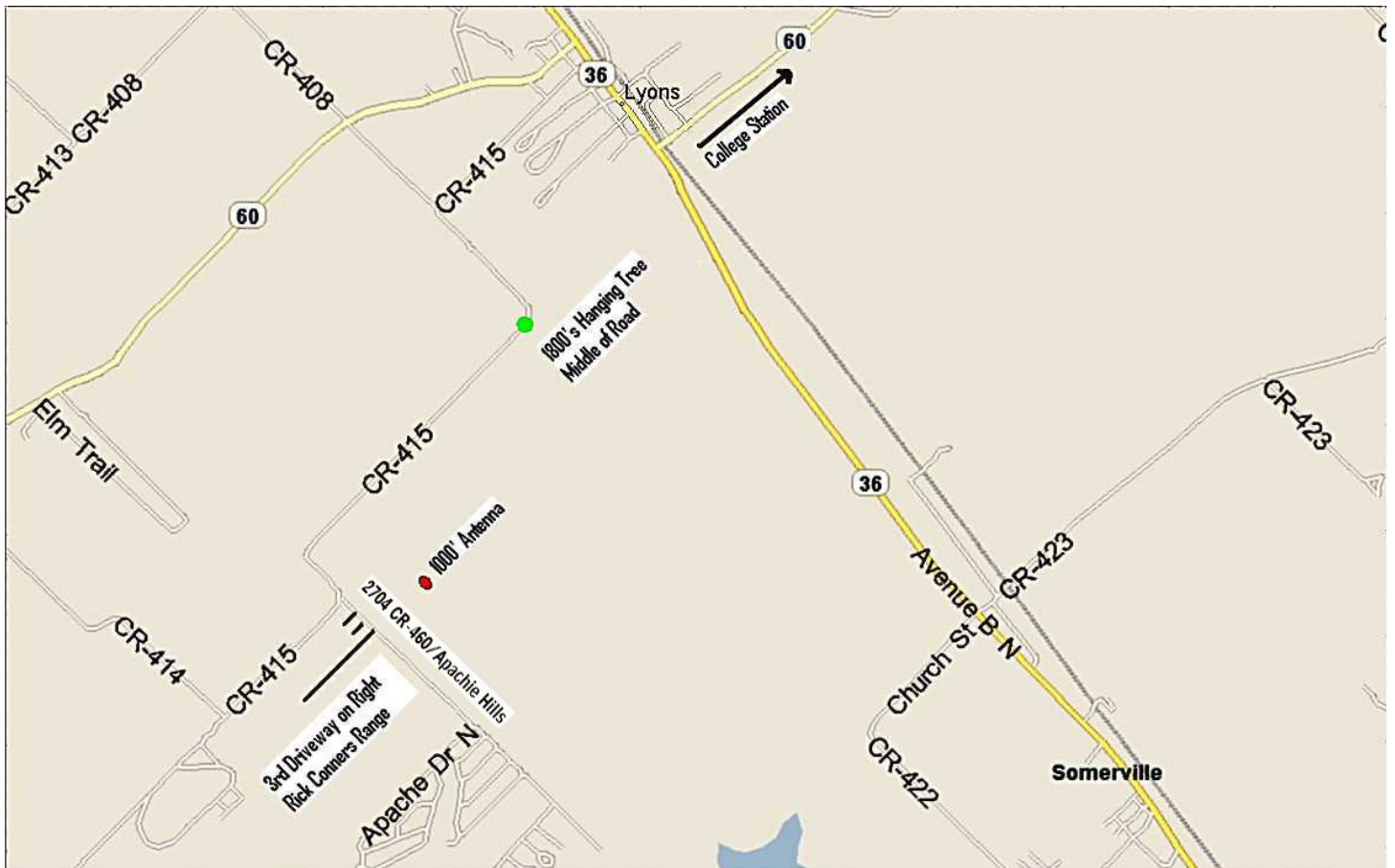

Date: 3rd Saturday of Every Month and pre-registration is not required.

Registration: Entry fees and sign in sheet must be filled prior to firing.

Range Location: From Summerville: go north 4 miles on HWY TX-36 Turn West on CR-415. From FM 2818 in College Station, go South West on HWY FM-60, 20 miles. From HWY 21 in Caldwell: Go South on HWY TX-36, 13.5 miles. Range Physical Address: 2704 CR-460 Lyons, TX 77863



Eligibility: All competitors are not required to be members of NRA or BVSRA.

Match Start Time: Match begins at 0830.

Rules: Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules apply.

Classification: NRA classification will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Assigned classifications may be used.

Scoring: Competitors will score targets during all matches. Scores are to be turned in following the competition of firing of each individual match. Failure to turn in scores will not be turned into the NRA. Seniors or competitors not physically able to score targets may ask for assistance.

Equipment: As appropriate for each individual match according to the most current NRA/CMP rules of competition.

Rifles: NRA match -Rule 3.3; or service rifle –Rules: 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.5 or 3.1.6. NO 7.62 x 39 caliber ammo.

Sights: Metallic only - Rule 3.7a

Ammunition: Ammunition will be furnished by the competitor. AP, Tracer, and/or incendiary ammunition will not be permitted.

Coaching: Will not be allowed, except with novice and junior shooters.

Targets: NRA SR-1, SR-21, and MR-31 bull's eye targets will be used.

Safety: Without exception, Eye and ear protection is required! Safety will be paramount in all activities! All rifles will have actions open with clips/magazines removed and an empty chamber indicator inserted into the chamber of the rifle except when on the line during prep period or during firing. Handling of rifles and policing of brass (collection of brass forward of the firing line) will only be permitted at the direction of the Range officer.

Range Rules: Persons appearing to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be allowed on the range. Children, juniors, and pets must be controlled and shall be the responsibility of their sponsors. Parking will be in designated areas only. Anyone violating these rules will be denied range privileges. Other action may be taken where deemed necessary.

Every 3rd Saturday Match

National Match Course of Fire (50 shots)

NRA Rule 7.14

Sighter Period:

10 minutes for unlimited sighting shoots – single load, single fire, at 100 yards on SR-1 target

Match 1:

3 - Minute preparation period, followed by 10 shots in 10 minutes for record.
Standing slow fire, 100 yards, SR-1 target. NRA Rules: 5.11, 7.1

Match 2:

3 - Minute preparation period, followed by 10 shots in 60 seconds for record.
Sitting or Kneeling, rapid fire, 100 yards, SR-1 target. NRA Rules: 5.8 or 5.10, 7.2

Match 3:

3 - Minute preparation period, followed by 10 shots in 70 seconds for record.
Prone rapid fire, 100 yards, SR-21 target. NRA Rules: 5.6, 7.3

Match 4:

3 - Minute preparation period, followed by 20 shots in 20 minutes for record.
Prone slow fire, 100 yards, MR-31 target. NRA Rules: 5.6, 7.4
